Therefore, an airfield is quite optimal. We could even build up a 1 km long acceleration event and if the teams invert their aerodynamics, we would have the possibility to have flying cars.

With the hangar and other buildings, we have enough space for the pits and big gatherings. The areas in front of the hangar will be used for the practice area and the brake test.

Another remarkable feature of this area will be the possibility to have the camping nearby. We are currently in discussion with the owner about this, but if everything goes according to plan you would sleep 200m away from you workstations. This is of course a dream for everyone who has attended a Formula Student event before.

In addition, the area is near a river and two beautiful lakes, which is perfect for a relaxing evening after a hard day when the event activities are done.
